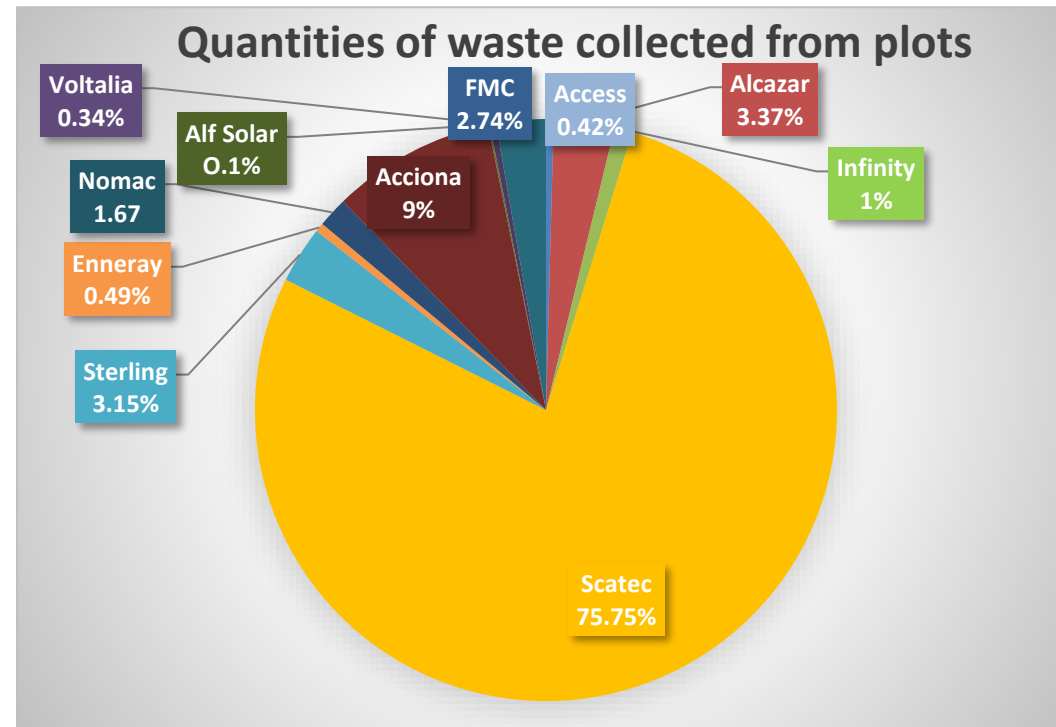

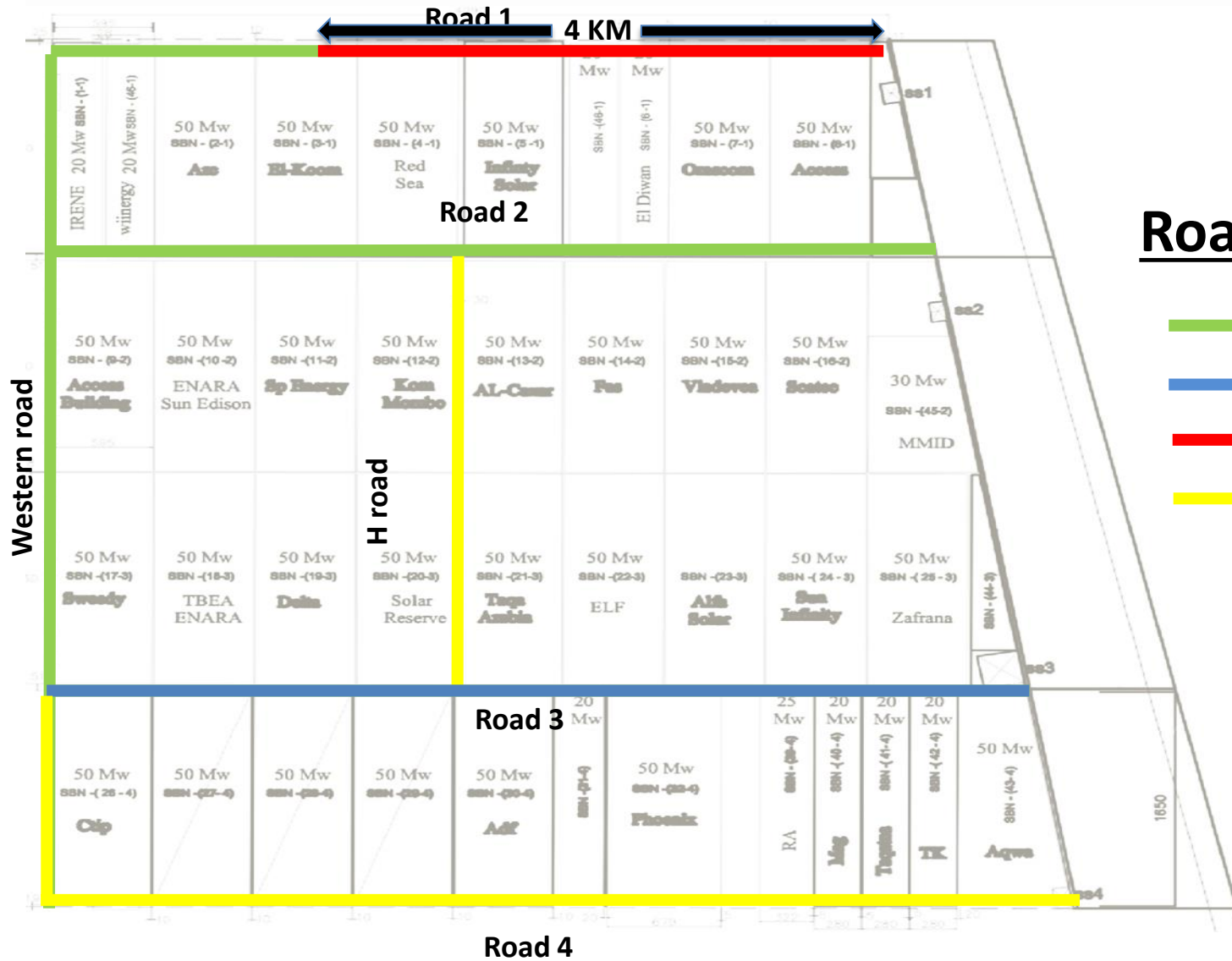

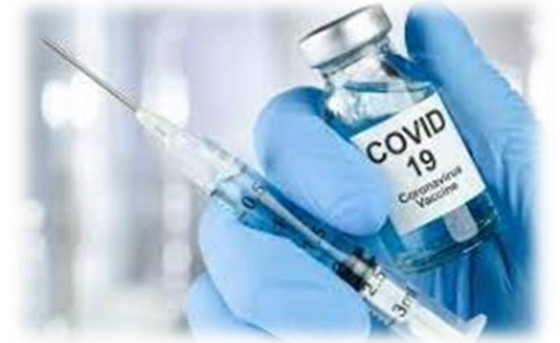
## Covid – 19 vaccination of Employees in Benban Solar Park

- There were 5 doses of Scorpion vaccine and 3 doses of snake vaccine



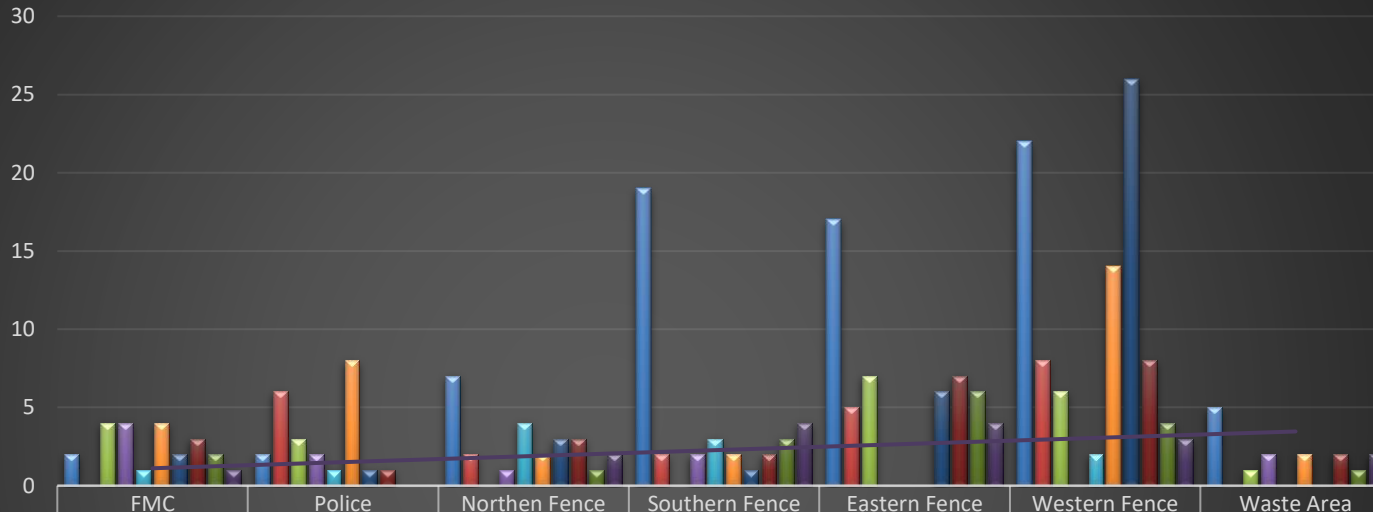
