- FMC is searching for sustainable solutions for using an authorized well for road maintenance which near the park, to reduce the costs for developers and FMC. > Traffic and Road maintenance FMC finished the maintenance of roads no.2 and no.3. FMC Started maintenance for other roads. There were a compliance received from developers about the speeding from some vehicles inside 3 the park which affects negatively of the production of the plots and of the road conditions. So, FMC will start to implement some excessive measures: Send reminder messages about traffic instructions (limit speed etc....) and send NCRs. Make checkpoints in cooperation with HSE team and Patrolling team, security team to stop vehicles which exceed the limit speed and withdraw the permit. Then communicate with developer. HSE Statistics (for developers) Number of Drills and Accident during last month: FMC conducted 3 drills (two with developers and one internal). Plots have 19 First Aid - cases. FMC made 2 General Site Inspection of the surrounding points. HSE Activity during this month: with Aswan HS Office There will be event in cooperation with Aswan OHS Office, Eng. Nagah Mohamed - director of Aswan OHS 4 office will be managing this event, expected to hold in the last of this month in the presence of the Minister of Manpower and the Governor of Aswan. FMC will be the sponsor for this event. with Egyptian Affairs Agency (EEAA) FMC has been informed that will get the environmental approval of Wastewater Treatment plant by next week. There was a meeting with Egyptian Environmental Affairs Agency about the environmental approval of Treatment plant and they suggested to make a protocol for perform trainings for waste management, whit is the Egyptian Environmental Affairs Agency and what are the required documents related to audits. It is expected to organize a meeting for make activities plan and will invite all developers. Pest Control The outcomes of the visits are concluded in: Surrounding Fences of the Park, FMC, Police accommodations and Waste Facilities area are protected well by using pest control system during the period of last year (12 visits) and we can notice decrease of infected traps from the above chart since visit No. 2. 5 **Conclusion:** Population, according to the above chart we can find that the number of the infected (eaten traps) were decreased since last visit (Visit No. 13) but in it still in the normal limits and this an indicator of the decrease of population of rodents in Benban project fences, FMC, Police and Waste Facilities Area.
